

Lunch Program FAQs

School Day Cafe offers lunch to ages 18 and under between 12:00 and 1:00 PM outside our kitchen by the playground.

- **Are there alternative meal options for children with allergies?**
 - Yes. When you complete the health form during camp registration, we will notify School Day Cafe about any dietary needs. They will then prepare the appropriate alternative lunches.
- **Where can I find the lunch menu?**
 - The menu can be found on the School Day Cafe website or at our front counter.
- **Does all food have to be consumed on site?**
 - Yes, all food provided by School Day Cafe must be eaten on-site during the designated lunchtime. So, campers are still encouraged to bring a snack for our later snack time.
- **What if my child is still hungry?**
 - We have "share buckets" available where campers can donate any unwanted sealed food or take extra food if they are still hungry.
- **Will they still provide lunch during holidays when the community center is closed?**
 - No, School Day Cafe will not be providing lunch on holidays when the community center is closed. Please plan accordingly for those days.
