- Flashlight, extra batteries or light sticks
- Fire extinguisher
- First aid kit
- Road Flares
- Paper maps; local, county, and state
- Battery-operated radio, extra batteries
- Re-sealable plastic bags
- Utility knife
- Jumper cables
- Tire changing equipment
- Hand cleanser
- Reflective roadside vest
- Note pad, marker/ pen
