The City of Santa Clarita respectfully opposes SB 649 related to the permitting of wireless and small cell telecommunications facilities.

On April 25, 2017, the Santa Clarita City Council voted unanimously to oppose SB 649. This bill would prohibit local discretionary review of small cell wireless antennas, including equipment collocated on existing structures or located on new "poles, structures, or non-pole structures," including those within the public rightof-way and buildings. The proposal preempts adopted local land use plans by mandating that small cells be allowed in all zones as a use by-right.

Bill Miranda Councilmember

> The City of Santa Clarita currently has in place, policies and procedures related to wireless and small cell telecommunications facilities. These adopted policies provide the City the ability to review and process small cell deployments based on unique local circumstances. SB 649 preempts the ability for local authorities to take into account unique local circumstances and instead, transfers control of public property to private telecommunications companies.

For these reasons, the City of Santa Clarita opposes SB 649.
