The City of Santa Clarita respectfully opposes SB 35 related to residential developments.

On April 25, 2017, the Santa Clarita City Council voted unanimously to oppose SB 35. This bill preempts public hearings of major multifamily residential developments and prohibits local authorities from issuing a conditional use permit on specific multifamily residential developments. Public hearings play a significant role in allowing members of the community to inform their local representatives of their support or concerns regarding potential development.

Bill Miranda Councilmember

> The City of Santa Clarita currently has in place, policies and procedures related to reviewing multifamily residential developments. This current process provides the City's Planning Department and the City's Planning Commission the ability to review multifamily residential developments based on unique local circumstances. SB 35 preempts the ability for local authorities to review unique local concerns regarding a development's effect on traffic, parking, and other development impacts.
