Impact On Operations:

Undetermined. Dependent upon scope of project. The State will allocate \$250,000 during Fiscal Year 2000-01 for site purchase. Initial construction estimate of \$80,000 consists of \$40,000 City match to the Historical Veterans Memorial Committee donation of \$40,000. Staff continues to evaluate potential costs based on proposed master park design.
