SUBJECT: SB 533 (STERN): SUPPORT

Dear Senator Stern:

On behalf of the Santa Clarita City Council, I am pleased to express our support for Senate Bill 533, relating to requiring electrical service providers to replace, harden, or underground any electrical infrastructure that experiences recurring de-energization events.

Our community has experienced several public safety power shutoff (PSPS) events, at times impacting over 25,000 businesses and households for periods of over 24 consecutive hours of power loss. On two occasions, December 23, 2020, and December 24, 2020, the City experienced major PSPS events that left thousands of residents without power and many with damaged devices or forced to discard perishable food items during a major holiday week.

This critical piece of legislation is thoughtfully designed and will accelerate the development and implementation of enhanced electrical utility infrastructure in areas that have been most impacted by deenergization events.
