As you know, the County of Los Angeles (County) is the largest County in the State and Country at over 10 million people. Requiring the County's Public Health Order to be based on Service Planning Area (SPA) data will refine health orders throughout the County to develop more relevant public health and clinical services that are targeted and reflective of specific community needs, as it relates to the COVID-19 pandemic.

> We are proud of the efforts and exceptional partnership with our medical service providers in serving and protecting our residents; however, it is not without cost. The economic impact to this region has been and will continue to be devastating, yet the rate of infection remains relatively low.

> The local economy in our region relies heavily on entertainment, film, aerospace production, retail, and food service - sectors that have all experienced significant disruptions in their operations and services under the public health orders. An individualized re-opening plan, incorporating local data and input from each SPA, will allow for tailored public health guidelines that better reflect the significantly lower rates of COVID-19 cases, sustainable resources, and hospital capacity in specific parts of the region, including the Santa Clarita Valley.

> We sincerely appreciate and support Assembly Bill 1251, as this important legislation strengthens local efforts to responsibly initiate the economic recovery process, while maintaining targeted public health measures to combat the spread of COVID-19.
