SUBJECT: AB 418 (VALLADARES): SUPPORT

Dear Assemblywoman Valladares:

On behalf of the Santa Clarita City Council, I am pleased to express our support for Assembly Bill 418, related to establishing the Community Power Resiliency Program. The Santa Clarita City Council voted unanimously to support this measure at the regular meeting on April 27, 2021.

As you know, the City has experienced several Public Safety Power Shutoff (PSPS) events, at times impacting over 25,000 households and businesses at periods of over 24 consecutive hours of power loss. Two major PSPS events occurred in Santa Clarita on December 23, 2020, and December 24, 2020, that left thousands of residents without power and many with damaged devices or forced to discard perishable food items during a major holiday week.

This critical piece of legislation establishes much needed resources to support local agencies in mitigating the impact of power outage events and improving electrical service reliability.

We have applied to the Community Power Resiliency Program in the past but, unfortunately, have not been awarded a grant. Assembly Bill 418 will ensure that a greater number of local agencies can leverage state resources to support local mitigation efforts in response to PSPS events.
