SUBJECT: AB 989 (GABRIEL): OPPOSE

Dear Assembly Member Gabriel:

On behalf of the Santa Clarita City Council, I am writing to respectfully express our opposition to Assembly Bill 989, related to establishing the Housing Accountability Committee. The Santa Clarita City Council voted unanimously to oppose this measure at the regular meeting on April 27, 2021.

The City has experienced a significant amount of growth in the last 30 years, more than doubling in population to approximately 225,512 residents. With such rapid growth, the City has worked diligently to ensure that residential development planning and standards recognize the unique community needs, topography, and geography of Santa Clarita.

The City recognizes the importance of land use planning and housing feasibility to meet the growth and needs of a community. While we appreciate your goal to ensure state housing law compliance and affordability, Assembly Bill 989 significantly preempts local land use authority.

Specifically, the bill's establishment of a Housing Accountability Committee preempts the Housing Accountability Act and allows a single hearing officer to unilaterally overturn conditions or denial of a project, without any public review or comment.

Furthermore, the City has the tools, knowledge, and policies in place to continue to plan and develop innovative residential units that enhance the quality of life for our community. It is critical for the City to maintain

local land use and zoning authority and ensure that the City continues to have the ability to consider unique factors and community characteristics when reviewing residential development proposals.

For these reasons, the City of Santa Clarita respectfully opposes Assembly Bill 989. We look forward to working with you to address our concerns.
