On behalf of the City of Santa Clarita (City), I am writing to respectfully express our opposition to Senate Bill 378, related to the preemption of fiber installation on public infrastructure and within the public right-of-way. The Santa Clarita City Council voted unanimously to oppose this measure at the regular meeting on April 27, 2021.

Cameron Smyth Councilmember The City recognizes the importance of efficient, reliable, and accessible internet service and wireless broadband. However, Senate Bill 378 significantly preempts the City's ability to apply careful discretion and local authority in the installation of fiber.

The City's current regulations intend to preserve the health, safety, and overall quality of life of our community, while ensuring a feasible review and processing of equipment installations in the public right-of-way, which includes micro-trenching.

Additionally, the City has experienced significant issues related to microtrenching projects by utility and telecommunication companies, including sub-standard coverings after micro-trenching projects, resulting in exposed trenches within a short period after the utility project and leaving the surface in worse condition than before the micro-trenching project.

Furthermore, it is likely that this legislation will cause increased wear and tear on public infrastructure, including roads and pathways, as Senate Bill 378 would undoubtedly cause a significant increase in micro-trenching within



the public right-of-way, with significant limitations on local discretion or authority.

For these reasons, the City respectfully opposes Senate Bill 378. We look forward to working with your office to address our concerns.
