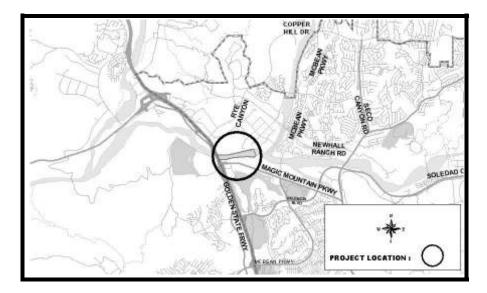
Project Location:Along the Santa Clara

recreational needs to the community.

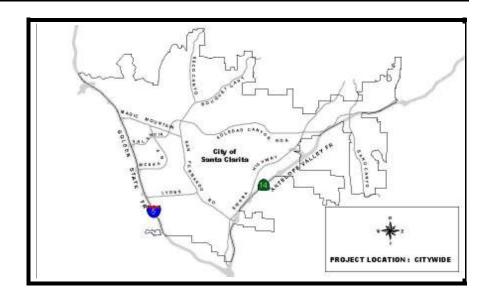

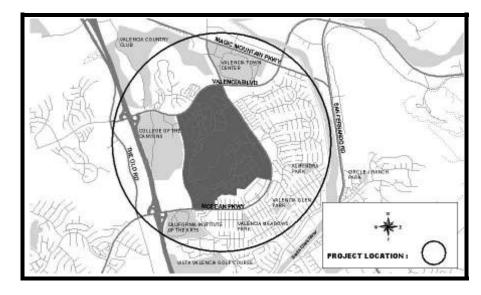

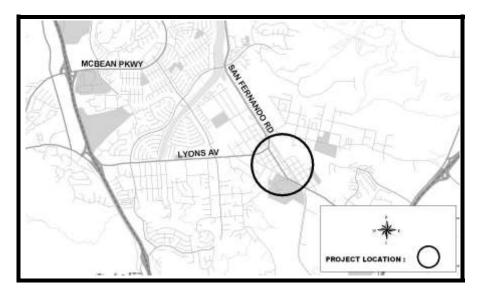
