WHEREAS, a proposed annual budget for the City of Santa Clarita for the Fiscal Year commencing July 1, 2007, and ending June 30, 2008, was submitted to the City Council and is on file in the City Clerk's Office, and

WHEREAS, the City Council has held a Public Hearing on the proposed budget on May 22, 2007, and

WHEREAS, the City Council has made certain revisions, corrections, and modifications to said proposed budget, and

WHEREAS, the City Manager has caused the proposed document to be corrected to reflect the changes ordered by the City Council.

NOW, THEREPORE, the City Council of the City of Santa Clarita does resolve as follows:

- SECTION 1. The budget, on file with the City Clerk incorporated herein by reference, is adopted by Resolution as the Annual Budget for the City of Santa Clarita for Fiscal Year commencing July 1, 2007, and enting June 30, 2008.
- SECTION 2. There is hereby appropriated to each account set forth in said budget, incorporated herein by reference, the sum shown for such account in the Fiscal Year 2007-2008 budget, and the City Manager is authorized and empowered to expend such sum for the purpose of such account but no expenditure by any office or department for any items within an account will exceed the amount budgeted therefore without prior approval of the City Manager.
- SECTION 3. The positions as they appear in the budget are authorized and approved for the Fiscal Year commencing July 1, 2007 and ending June 30, 2008.
- SECTION 4. All obligations and expenditures shall be incurred and made in the manner provided by pursuant to State law and City ordinances, resolutions and policies relative to purchasing and contract.
- SECTION 5 Each and every Fund listed in the budget is hereby ereated, continued, established and/or reestablished, as the case may be, and each Pund shall constitute a distinct accounting entity.

SECTION 6 This annual budget resolution shall apply to all funds except bond funds, grant funds, trust and agency funds, and capital funds. Legislative action by the City Council to issue bond, accept grants, and/or authorize capital projects shall be considered as authority of to expend funds for those purposes, subject to the requirements, restrictions and provisions of the State Law and the Santa Clarita Municipal Code relative to purchasing and contracting, and no further appropriation authority will be necessary.

SECTION 7. Transfers of amounts herein appropriated within departments, between departments and within the various funds created shall require the approval of the City Manager or his designee, provided the total appropriations for each Fund is not exceeded.

SECTION 8. The transfer of any amount of one Fund to another Fund and/or the appropriation of funds from Reserves and Fund Balance shall only be made pursuant to this budget resolution or subsequent official action of the City Council. When made by the City Council, such transfers and/or appropriations shall be considered amondments to the budget for the Fiscal Year commencing July 1, 2007 and ending June 30, 2008.

SECTION 9. The City Manager may approve any unused appropriations at the end of the Fiscal Year 2006-07 for capital projects, special projects and grant programs which shall become part of the City of Santa Clarita's budget for Fiscal Year 2007-08.

SECTION 10. All purchase order commitments outstanding on June 30, 2007, are hereby continued and will become a part of the City of Santa Clarita's budget for Fiscal Year 2007-08.

SECTION 11. The City Clerk shall certify to the adoption of this Resolution.

- E. That the appropriations limit documentation applicable to this Resolution has been available for public inspection for fifteen days prior to approval by the City Council, pursuant to Government Code section 7910.
- SECTION 2. That the appropriations limit for the City of Santa Clarita for fiscal year ending June 30, 2008 is \$230,997,936.

WHEREAS, for redevelopment plans adopted on or after January 1, 1994, Section 33607.5 of the Health and Safety Code provides that in any fiscal year in which a redevelopment agency receives tax increments, the community that has adopted the redevelopment project area may elect to receive, and the Agency shall pay into it, an amount equal to twenty-five percent (25%) of its proportional share of the tax increments received by the Agency, after the amount required to deposit in the Low and Moderate Income Housing Fund has been deducted ("City Election").

NOW, THEREFORE, the City Conneil of the City of Santa Clarita does hereby resolve as follows:

SECTION 1. The City Council hereby elects to receive all Increases as herein defined.

PROMISSORY NOTE

The Santa Clarita Redevelopment Agency, a redevelopment agency ("Agency"), for a good and valuable consideration, receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, does hereby agree to pay, on or before maturity, to the City of Santa Clarita, a municipal corporation ("City"), at Santa Clarita, California 91355, the sum of One Million Dollars (\$1,000,000), together with interest per annum thereon, at a rate equal to the prime rate minus one (1) point; "prime rate" as used herein shall mean the prime rate of interest quoted in the greater Los Angeles area as of July 1 of each calcular year during the term thereof, as published by the Board of Governors of the Federal Reserve System. \$1,000,000 is to be repaid to the General Fund.

Principal and interest shall be payable in lawful monies of the United States. Said principal and interest shall be paid at maturity, provided, at the option of the Agency, the entire balance of principal and interest may be paid prior to said maturity date.

Should litigation be reasonably necessary to enforce the provisions of this Note, the Agency shall pay, in addition to all other sums due on this note, an amount equal to reasonable attorneys' fees as set by the court, plus court costs incurred therein.
