Alphabet	De, Ee, and Ff
Character Building	Practice using our manners by saying "please" and "thank you" and staying in line
Creative Expression	Making spooky houses, dancing the "Dino-Dance," and exploring our emotions
Dramatic Play	Pumpkin Stand, pretending to fry eggs, raking leaves
Fine/Gross Motor	<u>Fine</u> : Q-tip painting, peeling and placing stickers, yarn lacing <u>Gross:</u> Hula-hoops, hopscotch, bean bag tossing
Health & Nutrition	Singing the "Handwashing" song to learn how to correctly wash the germs away
Math	Identifying and writing the number 1, counting to 24, estimating candy corn
Music	Learning the songs, "Leaves are Falling" and "Old McDonald."
People and Places	"Fun on the Farm" week for letter F will illustrate just how demanding a farmer's job is, as we learn how they take care of their land and animals.
Reading Readiness	Sounds and tracing of letters Dd, Ee, and Ff. Name recognition, reviewing letters A, B, and C
Safety & Environment	Using our "walking feet" in the classroom and pushing in our chairs when we get up from the table.
Science	Learning which animals hatch from an egg, "Will the egg crack?" science experiment, "What's inside a pumpkin?" exploration.
