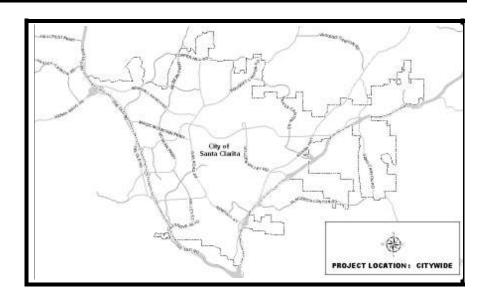

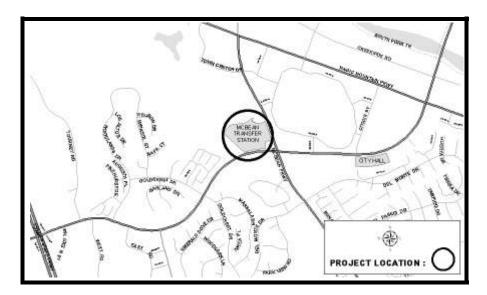

Description: The McBean Retional Transit Center (MRTC) Park and Ride lot will provide an additional 200 to 300 parking

spaces for Transit Center users. The project will also include bicycle lockers, a passenger drop-off area, bus layover pads, a commuter passenger platform, paving, lighting, and a pedestrian link to the exisiting McBean

Retional Transit Center and adjacent businesses.

Justification: These improvements have been identified as "Recommended" in the 2006 Transportation Development Plan

due to a deficiency of parking spaces for transit users. Construction of the additional parking facility demonstrates the City's commitment to supporting and promoting transit ridership for both local users and for

commuters.

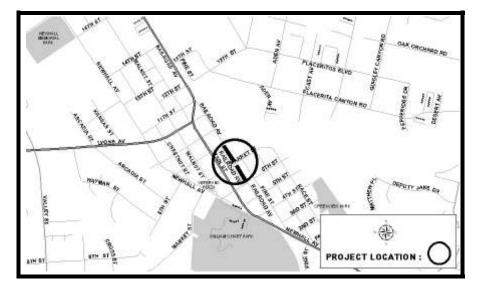

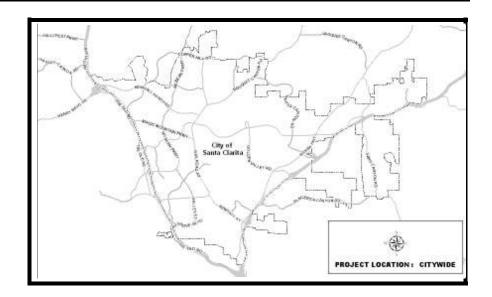

Mitchell and Rosedell Elementary Schools. Improvements include design and construction of curb extensions at selected locations, wider sidewalks, restriping of crosswalks, enhanced signage, and pedestrian count-down

signals.

by installing the extentions in areas of the City near schools grounds, and by increasing the visibility of school

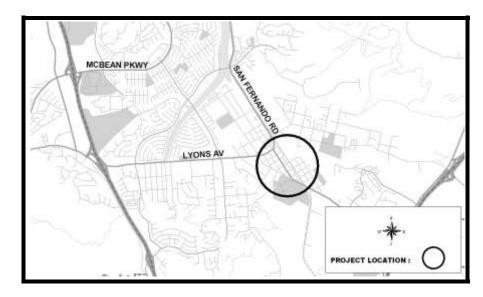
