
Project Location: Newhall Avenue at Sierra Highway.

Improvements will include construction of a landscaped median, restriping and traffic signal modifications to allow three travel lanes in each direction, and dual left-turns. It will also provide for a bus pull out area at the

southwest corner of the intersection.

Justification: Each year the City dedicates a portion of the capital budget for this effort. This annual commitment improves

traffic circulation by addressing necessary modifications to raised medians where traffic flow is impeded by left-turning vehicles. The construction effort is sponsored by the American Recovery and Reinvestment Act

of 2009.





Justification: Each year the City dedicates a portion of the capital budget to modify medians for improved traffic flow. This





Justification:


