ITEM 1OAK TREE ORDINANCE AND PRESERVATION GUIDELINES<br/>OVERVIEW - The Oak Tree Ordinance (Ord. No. 89-10) was passed by<br/>the City Council of the City of Santa Clarita on April 25, 1989. The Oak<br/>Tree Preservation Guidelines followed shortly thereafter on September<br/>11, 1990. The purpose of the Oak Tree Ordinance and the Oak Tree<br/>Preservation Guidelines is to "protect and preserve oak trees in the City,<br/>and provide regulatory measures designed to accomplish this purpose."<br/>The Ordinance grants the City the authority to protect oak trees within<br/>the City, while the Guidelines establish permit requirements,<br/>exemptions to the permit, the application process, oak tree reports, and<br/>criteria for maintaining oak trees.RECOMMENDED ACTION:<br/>Tree Ordinance and Preservation Guidelines and provide staff with

Tree Ordinance and Preservation Guidelines, and provide staff with direction on how to proceed.
