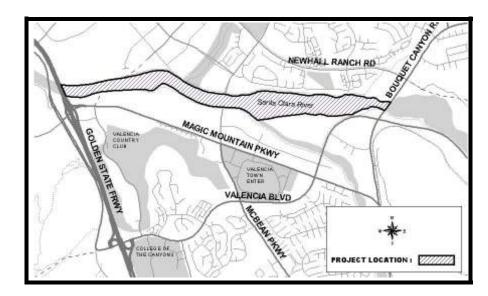
Project Location: Along the Santa Clara River from Bouquet Canyon Road to Interstate 5.

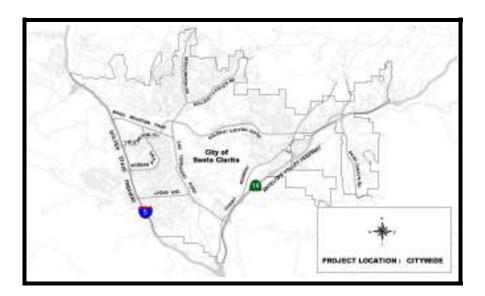

2005-06 HANDICAPPED ACCESS RAMP PROGRAM

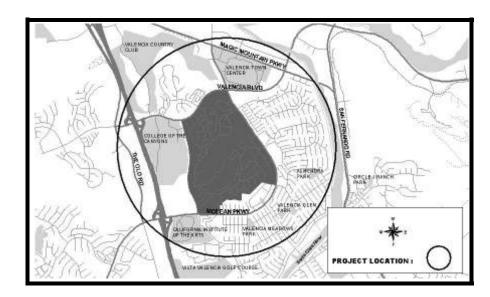


Project Location: Citywide.

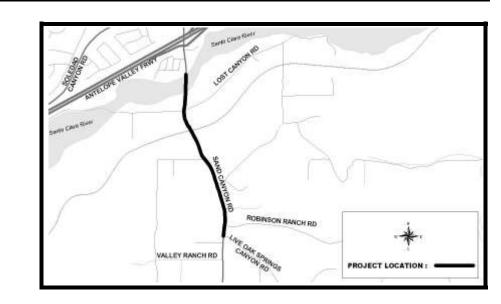
