STATEMENT TO BE SIGNED BY OWNER PRIOR TO ISSUANCE OF SWIMMING POOL PERMIT

POOL DRAINAGE REQUIREMENTS

The following are legal methods of swimming pool wastewater disposal:

- 1. Swimming pools, other than those using a salt water system, may be drained to a sanitary sewer through a 3" P-trap legally installed under permit from the Building and Safety Division of the City of Santa Clarita. Swimming pools may not be drained to the sewer during the following times: Monday through Friday between 5:00 a.m. and 9:00 a.m. Swimming pool wastewater shall not be discharged to a private sewage disposal (septic) system.
- 2. To the gutter in the street leading to a storm drain, provided the following requirements are met:
 - a. Notification shall be given to the City's Environmental Services Division at (661) 286-4098.
 - b. Pool water shall be dechlorinated, debrominated, have a neutral pH, and not contain any algae, algaecides, dyes, or detergents.
 - c. Pool filter backwash shall not be discharged to the storm drain system.
 - d. Swimming pools using a salt water system may not be drained to the gutter or storm drain.
- 3. To an improved storm or flood channel maintained by L.A. County Flood Control District (LACFCD) that adjoins your property. A permit shall first be obtained from the Construction Division for permits at (626) 458-4936. Swimming pools using a salt water system may not be drained to a storm or flood channel.
- 4. On the property, if the property is large enough to ensure that runoff will not encroach on any abutting properties.
- 5. In the case where none of the above can be accomplished, the pool contents must be removed by tank truck or pumping service.
