PARK HOURS – DAWN TO DUSK

This park is a shared public space provided by the City for your enjoyment and recreation. Be courteous and respectful to other riders and please help us in keeping the Bike Park clean.

BIKE PARK RULES

For the safe enjoyment of all visitors, please abide by the following rules:

1. Riders under 18 must wear a properly fitted and fastened helmet at all times.
2. Human-powered or pedal assisted bicycles only.
3. Keep food or drink off of any bike or jump lines.
4. Spectators must stay in the spectator area and are not permitted in the bicycle area or on features.
5. Users under the age of 12 must be accompanied by a parent, due to the nature of the hazardous recreation activity occurring at the Bike Park.
6. City Parks may not be used for commercial enterprise in any form.
7. Be respectful and courteous to your fellow park riders.
8. Bicycle riders shall at all time yield to pedestrians or other trail users.
9. No person shall ride bicycles in any area where signs are posted, or known to have been posted, prohibiting such activity.
10. Look before you ride. Inspect each feature prior to use – never jump blindly – have a spotter.
11. Look while you ride. Pay attention while riding by watching out for other riders. Do not stop in areas with poor visibility.
12. Only one person may use a feature at a time. Take turns and let everyone have a chance to ride.
13. No unauthorized building or modifications of features. No person shall install foreign obstacles, including but not limited to, ramps, rails, road cones, trash cans etc.

Prohibited Use and Activities

1. Motorized bikes of any kind
2. Alcoholic beverages, smoking, and drug use
3. Operation of remote-controlled, motorized, or self-propelled aircraft
4. Animals in the Bike Park
5. Vandalism of any form, including graffiti and stickers
6. Parking and overnight camping

WARNING

Ride at your own Risk

Bicycle racing or jumping, BMX bicycling, and mountain biking at this facility are hazardous recreation activities. Use of this facility may result in death, paralysis, brain damage, concussion, broken bones, or serious injury.
