

## **CODE OF CONDUCT**

The benefits of Recreation are endless - promoting health, building strong families, and creating a sense of community. To ensure the quality of programs and public safety, all program participants, parents, spectators, coaches, volunteers, and guests of the facility must abide by this Code of Conduct:

- Act with respect towards others; respect their privacy and personal safety
- Treat public and private property, the City facility, and equipment therein with respect
- Observe program rules and regulations at all times
- Behave in a responsible manner, always exercising self-discipline
- Cooperate with or assist the City staff in maintaining safety, order, and discipline

## NEVER TOLERATED BEHAVIORS AND REASONS FOR IMMEDIATE REMOVAL AND DISMISSAL

- Abusive language or disrespect towards a staff member, volunteer, another participant, or any member of the public
- Discourtesy or rudeness to a fellow participant, staff member, or volunteer
- Verbal, physical, or visual harassment of another participant, staff member, or member of the public of any kind
- Bullying or taking unfair advantage of any participant
- Theft
- Possession or unwarranted usage of alcoholic beverages or illegal drugs on City of Santa Clarita property, or reporting to the program while under the influence of drugs or alcohol
- Possession of dangerous or unauthorized materials such as firearms, weapons, or other similar items on City property
- Conduct that would endanger the life, safety, health, or well-being of others
- Failure to leave the facility in the condition in which you found it, including applicable restrooms, gym, hallways, locker rooms and any other area used this includes vandalism/graffiti
- Failure to follow any City of Santa Clarita policies or procedures

Failure to follow the rules noted above may result in a suspension from the facility or other penalties as determined by the City as provided for in Title 14 PARKS AND OTHER PUBLIC PLACES of the City of Santa Clarita Municipal Code.
